Position Description – The Office of the Circuit Executive is accepting applications for the position of unpaid Intern located in Washington, D.C. This internship will entail (a) reviewing and revising circuit procedures as a result of national policy or rule changes, (b) researching and analyzing issues related to the 2017 Circuit Judicial Conference, and (c) assisting with identifying options for enhancing tenant services. The intern will be exposed to a broad range of court administration issues, including opportunities to attend meetings of senior court leadership and court proceedings.

Qualifications – Candidates must possess excellent analytical, organizational, interpersonal, and communication skills.

Experience and Education – Candidates should have familiarity with spreadsheets and computerized databases. At least one year of college is preferred. Experience and demonstrated interest in judicial administration, the law, or public policy is highly desirable.

Conditions of Employment – Applicants must be a United States citizen or eligible to work in the United States. The candidate(s) selected for the position will be brought on provisionally pending the results of a background investigation. All interns are subject to strict confidentiality requirements.

Salary – This is an unpaid position. Course credit may be arranged with a candidate's educational institution, if appropriate.
